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Page 3 EXAMINER JONES: Let's call Case 14762, 1 Application of Chesapeake Exploration, LLC, to reinstate 2 Orders Number R-13303 and R-13303-A, approving statutory 3 unitization of the Chambers Strawn Unit Area, the 4 corresponding Chambers Strawn Unit Waterflood Project, 5 6 and certification of the waterflood project as an 7 enhanced oil recovery project pursuant to the Enhanced 8 Oil Recovery Act, Lea County, New Mexico. 9 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Michael 10 Feldewert, with the Santa Fe law office of Holland & Hart, appearing on behalf of the applicant, Chesapeake 11 Exploration, LLC. I have one witness here today. 12 13 EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances? Will the witness please stand, and will the court 14 15 reporter please swear the witness? 16 (One witness was sworn.) 17 TERRY FROHNAPFEL 18 Having been first duly sworn, testified as follows: 19 DIRECT EXAMINATION BY MR. FELDEWERT: 20 Please state your full name for the record, 21 Q. and identify for whom you are employed and in what 22 23 capacity. 24 My name is Terry Frohnapfel. I'm employed by Α. 25 Chesapeake Energy, and I'm a landman.

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Page 4 Are you familiar with the application that's Ο. 1 2 been filed in this case? 3 Α. Yes 0. What does Chesapeake seek under this 4 application? 5 Approved statutory unitization of the Chambers 6 Α. 7 Strawn Unit, approved corresponding waterflood project and approved certification of the waterflood project as 8 9 an enhanced oil recovery project. Mr. Frohnapfel, were those certifications Ο. 10 previously obtained under prior Division orders? 11 12 Α. Yes. Ο. If you'll turn to what's been marked 13 Chesapeake Exhibits 1 and 2, are these copies of the 14 prior Division orders that were entered in September of 15 16 2010, and then in October of 2010 approving of the Chambers Strawn Unit? 17 Α. 18 Yes. 19 And do they also then approve the Q. 20 corresponding waterflood project, as well as certification of that waterflood project as an enhanced 21 oil recovery project? 22 23 Α. Yes. 24 Did you testify as an expert in petroleum land Q. 25 matters in the Division cases that resulted in these

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Page 5 1 orders? 2 Α. Yes. And have you previously testified as an expert 3 Ο. in petroleum land matters in other cases before the 4 5 Division? 6 Α. Yes, I have. Are you still the land person that's 7 Q. responsible for the Chambers Strawn Unit area? 8 9 Α. Yes. Are you therefore familiar with the status of 10 Ο. 11 the Chambers Strawn Unit? 12 Α. Yes. I would tender 13 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Frohnapfel as an expert in petroleum land matters. 14 15 EXAMINER JONES: So qualified. 16 Ο. (By Mr. Feldewert) If we take a look at 17 what's been marked Chesapeake Exhibit Number 1, which is Division Order Number R-1303, Mr. Frohnapfel, that was 18 entered in September of 2010; correct? 19 20 Α. Correct. If I turn over to page 9 of that Exhibit 1 and 21 Ο. I look at paragraph 19, it indicates that the injection 22 23 authority granted by the Division shall terminate one 24 year after the date of this order if the unit operator 25 has not commenced injection operations into the well.

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Page 6 Was Chesapeake able to commence injection 1 operations within a year of this order? 2 3 Α. No. Q. Would you please explain to the Examiner what 4 5 happened that prevented the company from proceeding with 6 its injection operations? Well, we mainly had problems getting 7 Α. 8 right-of-ways through. We had an initial plan of bringing water in from our Big Bertha waterflood -- I 9 mean Big Bertha Saltwater disposal system about four or 10 11 five miles away, and we encountered problems a lot more involved than we initially thought. 12 So we had to bore under a road, highway, and 13 14 we got to be -- we weren't -- we had several different 15 routes picked out, and none of them were without their problems. 16 17 So we had a second option. We got a water agreement in place with a company called Gandy 18 Corporation. And they were actually closer, and they had 19 a saltwater disposal system probably within a mile, and 20 so we got a water agreement with them. 21 22 And since then, their disposal system 23 developed problems. It's pressuring up, and it's not 24 going to be able to give us the volume that we need. So we plan on trucking water from several wells that we 25

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Page 7 operate. 1 2 Ο. Does the company anticipate being in a position within the next year to commence injection 3 operations? 4 5 Α. Yes. Ο. Is that why you're then seeking to reinstate 6 by this application Orders Numbers 13303 and 13303-A, 7 which have been marked as Exhibit Numbers 1 and 2? 8 9 Α. Yes. Why don't you -- I'm going to go out of order 10 Ο. for a minute. Why don't you turn to what's been marked 11 12 Exhibit Number 5? (Witness complies.) 13 Α. Is this a map that identifies the Chambers 14 Q. 15 Strawn Unit area? The red outline is the Chambers Strawn 16 Α. Yeah. Unit area. And the three wells that are highlighted with 17 the window box, those are the wells that we're going to 18 bring water from. Those are Chesapeake-operated wells. 19 20 0. Then within the Chambers Strawn Unit area in red, we see three blue squares. What do those depict? 21 22 Α. Those are the three wells that make up the three active wells in the Chambers Strawn Unit. Two of 23 24 them are going to be converted to injection wells, and the one in the center will remain as a producer. 25

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Page 8 Q. That was the authority to commence -- the 1 authority to commence these operations was granted by the 2 Division in the orders that have been marked as Exhibits 3 1 and 2? 4 5 Α. Correct. 6 Q. What is the character of the land in the unit area? 7 Α. It's all fee. 8 Is Chesapeake Exhibit Number 3 -- is this an 9 Q. affidavit confirming that notice of this application to 10 reinstate these order was provided to the affected 11 parties? 12 13 . Α. Yes. 14 If I take a look at what is now the third page 0. of that exhibit, the third and fourth pages, does that 15 contain a list of the parties that were notified of this 16 application to reinstate the prior Division orders? 17 18 Α. Yes. 19 And does that list include all the working Q. interest owners in the unit area? 20 21 Α. Yes, it does. 22 Q. Does it also include all the non-costbearing interest owners in the unit area? 23 24 Α. Yes. 25 Does it include, as well, then on page 4 of Q.

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Page 9 that exhibit, the surface owners for the two injection 1 2 wells that were previously approved by the Division? Α. Yes. 3 And did you also examine whether there were Ο. 4 any leasehold operators within a half mile of the each of 5 6 the two injection wells previously approved by the Division? 7 Α. Yes. There are none. 8 There are none? 9 Ο. Α. Right. 10 All right. If I look through this notice Ο. 11 list, I observe we are missing a return receipt from a 12 Piyush V. Patel and Meena Patel Family Trust, which has 13 an address there in Midland, Texas? 14 15 Α. Correct. What's the -- first off, what's the nature of 16 Ο. 17 that particular interest? 18 Α. It's a working interest. It's less than 1 19 It's about two-tenths of 1 percent. percent. We've never been able to contact these people or find them. 20 That was their last address of record in the courthouse. 21 And we talked to other interest owners and 22 23 looked in other public records and Internet sites and different telephone directories and can't find them. 24 25 Q. Were you also able to contact other

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Page 10 individuals with the last name of Patel? 1 Α. Yes, and they were unfamiliar with this 2 3 person. Now, did you likewise -- were you likewise 4 Ο. unable to locate this particular interest prior to the 5 entry of the Division orders that previously approved the 6 Chambers Strawn Unit? 7 Α. Yes. 8 The other return receipt that we are missing 9 0. here for purposes of this application was from Shelley 10 Marsh Rice. What's the nature of her interest? 11 She's got a royalty interest, and we've always 12 Α. been able to get in contact with her through that 13 address. She signed the -- she ratified the unit 14 agreement, and then she re-ratified it later. 15 So that 16 address is good. 17 We just didn't get the return receipt. We didn't get the letter back saying it was undeliverable. 18 We just didn't receive the receipt, so we're thinking 19 it's still good. 20 I tried to contact her, but I don't have a 21 phone number for her. 22 Were all of the interest owners that were 23 Q. listed here likewise subject of notice in the proceedings 24 25 previously that resulted in the entry of the Division

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Page 11 orders approving the Chambers Strawn Unit? 1 Α. Yes. 2 Okay. Is Chesapeake Exhibit Number 4 an 3 Q. affidavit of publication of this matter in the Lovington 4 Leader? 5 6 Α. Yes. Were Exhibits 1 through 5 compiled under your 7 Ο. direction and supervision? 8 9 Α. Yes. 10 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, I move the admission into evidence of Chesapeake Exhibits 1 through 11 12 5. EXAMINER JONES: Exhibits 1 through 5 will 13 be admitted. 14 15 (Exhibits 1 through 5 were admitted.) 16 MR. FELDEWERT: I would further ask that the record from Case Numbers 14477 and 14478, which 17 resulted in the two orders that are marked as Chesapeake 18 Exhibits Numbers 1 and 2, we ask that that record 19 20 likewise be incorporated into this case for purposes of reinstating these orders. 21 The records in Cases 22 EXAMINER JONES: 14477 and 14478 shall be incorporated into this case. 23 24 MR. FELDEWERT: That concludes our 25 presentation.

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Page 12 1 EXAMINATION 2 BY EXAMINER JONES: Okay. I think I have -- the only question 3 0. before I turn it on over to Mr. Brooks is that the final 4 5 unit agreement, do you have a copy of that, or the -- you 6 have a unit agreement and a working interest agreement; is that correct? 7 We have a unit agreement and a unit operating 8 Α. 9 agreement. I do have a copy. We usually -- the language I see in our 10 Ο. 11 permits is to incorporate by reference. But you do have -- it's pretty much finalized at this point? 12 13 Α. Right. 14 EXAMINER JONES: So it wouldn't hurt for 15 us to get a copy, do you think, Mr. Brooks? EXAMINER BROOKS: I think they should be 16 17 filed. Of course, it's hard for us to ever find these agreements. Whenever I look for one, you don't seem to 18 be able to find it. 19 MR. FELDEWERT: The only thing I can offer 20 is that both the documents you were talking about were 21 22 part of the examination in the subject of the prior 23 orders, including the second order, which dealt with an 24 amendment to the description of the unitized interval, I 25 think it was.

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Page 13 EXAMINER BROOKS: Are the unit 1 agreements -- were they admitted as exhibits in the 2 previous proceedings? 3 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Brooks, I don't 4 5 remember if they were or not. I haven't checked the 6 orders to see if they reference them or not. We'd be 7 happy to get copies to you. EXAMINER BROOKS: I think that would be 8 good if you could file them as part of this proceeding so 9 we have them. 10 EXAMINER JONES: I'll turn it over to 11 12 David. 13 EXAMINER BROOKS: I really don't have any questions. 14 15 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. With that, thank 16 you for coming. And we'll take this case, Case 14762, under advisement. 17 18 MR. FELDEWERT: Just as a matter of 19 clarification, do you need both the unit agreement and the unit operating agreement? 20 21 EXAMINER BROOKS: I would think so, yes. 22 MR.
