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completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Nearburg Producing Company as operator and a charge for risk involved in drilling the well. The proposed well and lands are located approximately one mile northwest of Seven Rivers, New Mexico.

Application of COG Operating, LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Falabella "31" Fee Well No. 4H, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 150 feet from the South line and 1040 feet from the East line (Unit P) to a bottom hole location 330 feet from the North line and 1040 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 31. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 17 miles North of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
