There's a couple EXAMINER STOGNER: 3 of matters that I'll call today because I started hearing 4 them some time ago. 5 At this time I'm going to call Case Number 6 This is the Application of Chi Energy, Inc., for 7 13,449. compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 8 This case was heard on March 17th but was 9 continued to today's docket for notification purposes or 10 11 other, Mr. Bruce. Are there any other appearances? 12 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, the case was heard, Chi 13 presented its case, and a Mr. Daniel McNabb appeared and 14 15 asked for a little more time. The parties have been in 16 negotiations. 17 Mr. McNabb is not the only party being pooled. There's about three and a half percent working interest, 18 other than Mr. McNabb, who are being pooled. 19 They're 20 either unlocatable or they have not responded to the 21 offers. 22 Mr. McNabb owns approximately a 15-percent 23 interest. At the hearing he stated that he had conveyed 90 percent of his interest to Xeric Oil and Gas Corporation. 24

I've been in touch with my client, and Xeric has committed

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its 90 percent of 15-percent interest to the well and does 1 not need to be pooled. Mr. McNabb and Chi Energy are on 2 the verge of signing an operating agreement, and I think 3 they can be safely dismissed -- he can also be safely 4 dismissed from the case and -- leaving the other 5 unresponsive or unlocatable mineral owners to be pooled. 6 Okay, and there's nothing EXAMINER STOGNER: 7 further in this matter.
