FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, we've 6 7 appeared in both of these cases, so on behalf of Yates 8 Petroleum, Myco, Abo. We're also appearing today, on 9 behalf of Concho, in Cases 14770 and 14771. 10 Mr. Bruce is right. The parties are very 11 close, we believe, to reaching an agreement, a joint 12 operating agreement, that will resolve at least one, if 13 not both of these cases. We realize the Division has their continuance rule, but we, as the effected parties, 14 15 would move the Commission to continue this case for an additional two weeks. We think that -- we know that the 16 17 parties have exchanged revision and modification to a 18 joint operating agreement this week. We understand 19 they're very close, and I think it would be fruitful for 20 everyone involved to continue this case for two weeks --21 both of these matters for two weeks. 22 EXAMINER BROOKS: Well, pursuant to the 23 Director's policy, and perhaps wisely, it did not allow 24 for any exceptions. So if you are not -- if you do not 25 wish to go forward with these cases, we will dismiss

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Page 5 them without prejudice, and they can be refiled. 1 Well, Mr. Examiner, I don't 2 MR. BRUCE: 3 really want to dismiss them. I could put them on there just simply by affidavit. 4 5 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. MR. BRUCE: But I would put in a request 6 that no order be issued until Mr. Feldewert and I can 7 8 come back in the next couple of weeks. EXAMINER BROOKS: Well, that, I think, is 9 something we can comply with. Usually we get requests 10 11 for orders to be expedited or something (laughter). If you want us to delay an order, that's something very 12 intuitive. 13 14 MR. FELDEWERT: And just as a matter of clarification, I guess we were hoping that perhaps if it 15 16 was the affected parties that moved for a continuance, 17 that might allow an exception to the Division's normal 18 policy, and that's why we were actually moving to 19 continue. 20 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah. I actually don't 21 have any instructions that allow for exceptions. We $2^{\cdot}2$ prefer that you put them on, rather than having them 23 dismissed, so we will go ahead and put them on today. 24 Did you express a desire to put them on first or --25 MR. BRUCE: It's up to the -- it doesn't
