Docket Nos. 20-12 and 21-12 are tentatively set for July 12, 2012 and July 26, 2012. Applications for hearing must be filed at least 30 days in advance of hearing date. OCD Rule 19.15.4.13.B requires parties who intend to present evidence at an adjudicatory hearing to file a pre-hearing statement no later than the Thursday before the hearing, and serve a copy on opposing counsel of record. If the OCD does not receive a pre-hearing statement from the applicant by the close of business on the Thursday before the hearing, the hearing may be continued. The following cases will be heard by an Examiner.

- 1. <u>CASE 14862</u>: Application of ConocoPhillips Company and Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company (collectively "COPC") for pre-approval of downhole commingling of production on a pool-wide basis for the Basin-Mancos Gas Pool. San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico. Applicants seek an order, pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.12.11.D(2), on a pool-wide basis for Basin-Mancos Gas Pool with production from the Dakota and Mesaverde formations such that approval to downhole commingle any pool combination thereof can be submitted and approved by the Division's Aztec district office. The Basin-Mancos Gas Pool extends throughout the San Juan Basin located within San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico
- 2. <u>CASE 14863</u>: Application of LRE Operating, LLC, for approval of a salt water disposal well, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order proposing to utilize its Eddy-Humble "4" State No. 1, located 2310 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line, Unit J, Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico as a produced water disposal well. Applicant proposes to inject produced water into the Abo, Wolfcamp and Cisco formations. The well is located approximately 7 miles southwest of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
- 3. CASE 14864: Application of Parallel Petroleum LLC for approval of a Unit Agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks approval of the High Hopes Exploratory Unit for all formations and geological structures from the surface to the base of the Mississippian Lime formation or 7,500 feet whichever is deeper in an area comprising 12,482.52 acres, more or less, of Federal, State of New Mexico and Fee Lands in all or portions of Sections 1-4, 8-11, 14-17, 20-22, 27-29 and 32-33, of Township 18 South, Range 21 East, NMPM which is located approximately 6 miles south southwest of Hope, New Mexico.
