STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order approving an 80-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta-Yeso formation comprised of the W/2SE/4 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) from the surface to the base of the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the NW/4SE/4 of Section 25 to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (ii) the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the W/2SE/4 of Section 25 to form a non-standard 80 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Boot Hill 25 Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NW/4SE/4, and a terminus in the SW/4SE/4, of Section 25. Also to be

considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
