APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR A NON-STANDARD OIL SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT AND COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

AAMENDED APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order (i) approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Yeso formation comprised of the W½E½ of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying the non-standard unit, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the $W\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 13, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Wyatt Draw 13 OB Well No. 1 to a depth sufficient to test the Yeso formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate the W½E½ of Section 13 to the well to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing. The well is a horizontal well, with a surface location 250 feet from the north line and 2190 feet from the east line of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., and a terminus at an orthodox location in the NW¼NE¼ of Section 13.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the $W\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 13 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.

Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the W½E½ of Section

13, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17, 18.

5. Approval of the non-standard unit and the pooling of all mineral interests

underlying the W½E½ of Section 13 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent

waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its

order:

A. Approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Yeso

formation comprised of the W½E½ of Section 13;

B. Pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying the W½E½ of

Section 13;

C. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

D. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost

among the well's working interest owners;

E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together

with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in

the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Yeso formation comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying the W/2E/2 of Section 13 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Wyatt Draw 13 OB Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location 250 feet from the north line and 2190 feet from the east line of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, and a terminus at an orthodox location in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 13. The producing interval of the wellbore will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 4-1/2 miles west-northwest of Lakewood, New Mexico.
