APPLICATION

Nadel and Gussman Permian L.L.C. applies for an order (i) approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the E½W½ of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the non-standard unit, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the $E\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the Super Chief Well No. 1 to a depth sufficient to test the Glorieta-Yeso formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate the E½W½ of Section 24 to the well to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The well is a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE½SW¼, and a terminus in the NE½NW¼, of Section 24.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the $E\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the wells or to otherwise commit their interests to the wells, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E½W½ of Section 24, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17, 18.

5. Approval of the non-standard unit and the pooling of all mineral interests underlying the E½W½ of Section 24 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the E½W½ of Section 24;
- B. Pooling all mineral interests in the E½W½ of Section 24 as to the Glorieta-Yeso formation;
- C. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- E. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the costs among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Application of Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C. for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta-Yeso formation comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Super Chief Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE/4SW/4, and a terminus in the NE/4NW/4, of Section 24. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The units are located approximately 4-1/2 miles southeast of Atoka, New Mexico.

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
