Back on the 1 2 record. 3 Mr. Bruce, I assume that you want to combine -- want to consolidate 14842 and 14843 for 4 purposes of hearing. 5 That's correct. 6 MR. BRUCE: CHAIRMAN BROOKS: All right. Very good. 7 I will call at this time Case Number 8 14842, application of Cimarex Energy Company for 9 10 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico, and Case Number 14843, application of Cimarex Energy 11 Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, 12 New Mexico. 13 14 I call for appearances. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce, of 15 Santa Fe, representing the applicant. I intend to 16 17 present these cases by affidavit. 18 MR. RANKIN: Mr. Examiner, Adam Rankin, with Holland & Hart, Santa Fe, on behalf of COG 19 20 Operating, appearing in both cases. Appearing in both cases? 21 CHAIRMAN BROOKS: MR. RANKIN: Correct, for COG Operating. 22 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I have submitted 23 three exhibits to you. Just if you would look --24 turn back to the land plat. Attachment A to the 25

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1	Exhibit 1, the statement of Cimarex's landman, the	J.
2	wells being drilled are in the southwest/northeast	
3	of Section 6 and the southeast/northeast of Section	
4	6 of Township 19 south, Range 26 east.	
5	You can see the two well units outlined.	
6	Actually, that south half of the northeast quarter	
7	is or was originally patented as a single Fee	
8	tract.	
9	CHAIRMAN BROOKS: Okay. What were the	
10	township and range?	
11	MR. BRUCE: 19/26.	
12	CHAIRMAN BROOKS: Go ahead.	
13	MR. BRUCE: And they have the same well	
14	name, so I I consolidated them, although there is	
15	a difference in ownership. But nonetheless, this	
16	is as I think you will recall an area that	
17	there were some fights some substantial fights	
18	between COG and Cimarex, in which they split up the	
19	areas they were going to operate.	
20	This is one of those areas. And in fact	
21	late last week, COG did and Cimarex did sign a	
22	JOA regarding these two wells, so we're not seeking	
23	to force pool COG.	
24	The two wells are the Alabama 6 Fee Well	
25	Number 1, which will be a Glorieta Yeso test in the

Page 5 1 southwest quarter/northeast quarter of Section 6, and then the Alabama 6 Fee Well Number 4, which is a 2 Glorieta Yeso test in the southeast 3 guarter/northeast guarter of Section 6. 4 I believe the pool in this area is the 5 I think it's the Penasco San Andres 6 Penasco. 7 Glorieta Yeso, something like that. I can verify the pool name for you, but I believe that's what it 8 9 is. 10 CHAIRMAN BROOKS: Okay. MR. BRUCE: Anyway, the parties being 11 pooled are identified on the second page of the 12 13 affidavit. The interest ownership does vary somewhat 14 in the two well units. The applicant does request a 15 200 percent risk charge. And the overhead rates are 16 17 4,500 a month for a drilling well and 450 a month for a producing well. These are vertical wells. 18 The correspondence is attached to the 19 interest owners, one of whom is unlocatable. 20 21 And the AFEs are attached. These wells 22 will cost approximately \$2.3 million each. Attached as -- submitted as Exhibit 2 is 23 24 the affidavit of notice whereby Yates, Abo, and Myco 25 did receive actual notice of this well and some

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Page 6 1 other wells in this area. Normally I would have sent separate 2 letters, but it was actually Mr. Moran, Yates' 3 landman, who asked me to conglomerate them into one 4 package to minimize his paperwork. 5 And finally, Exhibit 3 is the affidavit of 6 7 publication in the Carlsbad newspaper, whereby notice was given to Mr. Gustof Johnson or his heirs, 8 who is a person who was unlocatable after the normal 9 10 county search, Internet search, et cetera. And with that, we would move the admission 11 12 of Exhibits 1 through 3 and we ask that the matters be taken under advisement. 13 CHAIRMAN BROOKS: Okay. Exhibits 1 14 through 3 are admitted. 15 I suppose the difference in the overhead 16 rate had something to do with the fact that -- your 17 18 agreement with COG? MR. BRUCE: It is. Cimarex has been 19 20 asking, for its vertical wells, a lower overhead 21 rate. CHAIRMAN BROOKS: 22 Yeah. But the previous case included -- well, the previous case was not 23 24 Cimarex. That was... 25 MR. BRUCE: That was -- correct. That was
