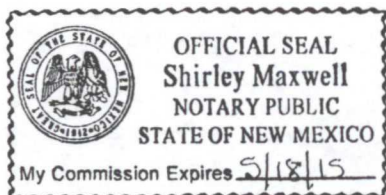

### NOTICE

To: Julia McKinley, or her heirs or devisees: Marshall & Winston, Inc. seeks an order approving an 80-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta-Yeso formation comprised of the W/2SE/4 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (I) from the surface to the base of the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the NW/4SE/4 of Section 25 to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (II) the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the W/2SE/4 of Section 25 to form a non-standard 80 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area), for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Boot Hill 25 Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NW/4SE/4, and a terminus in the SW/4SE/4, of Section 25. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Monday, June 25, 2012 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this mat-
