 - Application of LRE Operating, LLC, for approval of a salt water disposal well, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order proposing to utilize its Eddy-Humble "4" State No. 1, located 2310 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line, Unit J, Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico as a produced water disposal well. Applicant proposes to inject produced water into the Abo, Wolfcamp and Cisco formations. The well is located approximately 7 miles southwest of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
- 2. <u>CASE 14881</u>: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.
