STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Order No. R-13533 (i) approved a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, and (ii) pooled of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2E/2 of Section 33. The unit is dedicated to the Chaparral 33 Fed. Com. Well

No. 3, a horizontal well at an unorthodox surface location 230 feet from the north line and 810 feet from the east line, with a terminus in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 33. The order pooled a number of people, including Tom Beall, Carolyn Beall, and Fuel Products, Inc.

Tom Beall, Carolyn Beall, Fuel Products, Inc., Pear Resources, and Gardenia Investments, Ltd. entered appearances in the case and have appealed the order to the Commission.

Applicant requests that the appeal be dismissed, for the following reasons:

1. Subsequent to entry of Order No. R-13533, Tom Beall, Carolyn Beall, and Fuel Products, Inc. signed applicant's operating agreement. **Cimarex Exhibit No. 1** (signature pages to operating agreement).
2. Pear Resources and Gardenia Investments, Ltd. own no interest in the well unit, and hence are not subject to the order. **Cimarex Exhibit No. 2** (listing of interest owners in the well unit).

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal is moot.
