\* Under certain conditions, a well being diffied under a \$5,000.00 or \$7,500.00 bond may be permitted to be driffed as much as 500 feet deeper than the normal maximum depth, i.e., a well being driffed under a \$5,000.00 bond may be permitted to go to 5,499 feet, and a well being driffed under a \$7,500.00 bond may be permitted to go to 10,500 feet.
