De Novo Case 14763, the application of Mack Energy Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico, to be heard De Novo upon the application of Siana Oil and Gas LLP and Tom Ragsdale, was called and continued to the Commission meeting scheduled for September 13, 2012.

De Novo Case 14764, the application of Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit, an unorthodox location, and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico, to be heard De Novo upon the application of Thomas M. Beall, Carolyn R. Beall, Fuel Products, Inc., Pear Resources, and Gardenia Investments, Ltd., was called and continued to the Commission meeting scheduled for August 16, 2012.

After a motion by Commissioner Dawson and a second to the motion by Commissioner Balch, the minutes of the June 20-22, June 27, and June 28, 2012 Commission meetings were unanimously approved and adopted.

Reopened Case 14720, Agave Energy Company's Motion to Amend Order No. R-13507, was called for final action.
