Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit (project area) for any pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Snoddy Fed. Well No. 21, a horizontal well to with a surface location in the NE/4NE/4, and a terminus in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 26.
