

Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2S/2 of Section 1 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 or 80 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit will be dedicated to the Mongoose Fee Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NW/4SW/4, and a terminus in the NE/4SE/4, of Section 1. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 18, 2012 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
