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IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION, ("Yates") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17(C), for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface through the base of the Morrow formation in the following described acreage in Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM: the E/2 to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on a 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-Permo Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Penasco Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, and the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool; the SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated North Dagger-Draw Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and the SW/4 SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Yates is a working interest owner in the E/2 of said Section 6 and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Yates proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit to its Rushing "NJ" Deep Com Well No. 3 to be drilled at a standard location 1030 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line to an approximate depth of 12,000 feet to test all formations from the surface through the base of the Morrow formation.
- 3. Yates has sought and been unable to locate and thereby obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from Billy J. Walcott (Deceased), c/o Bobby Walcott, 8211 New Hampshire Street, NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87110-2424.
- 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit Yates the opportunity to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Yates Petroleum Corporation should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 7, 2005 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. pooling all mineral interests in the subject spacing units,
- B. designating Yates Petroleum Corporation operator of this spacing unit and the well to be drilled thereon,
- C. authorizing Yates Petroleum Corporation to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well,
- D. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures, and
- E. imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Yates Petroleum Corporation in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface through the base of the Morrow formation in the following described acreage in Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM: the E/2 to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on a 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-Permo Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Penasco Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, and the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool; the SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated North Dagger-Draw Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and the SW/4 SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Yates Petroleum Corporation as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 10 miles northwest of Lakewood, New Mexico.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Yates Petroleum Corporation has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation in the following described acreage in irregular Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM: the E/2 to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on a 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-Permo Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Penasco Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, and the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool; the SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated North Dagger-Draw Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and the SW/4 SE/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool. Said units are to be dedicated to Rushing NJ Deep Com Well No. 3 to be drilled 1030 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 6 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface through the base of the Morrow formation.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on April 7, 2005. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe Offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-hearing Statement three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must be filed at the Division's Santa Fe office lat the above specified address and should include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to



testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
