





For Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling the owner of operating rights under federal oil and gas lease No. NMNM 0553777 covering the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, in all formations from the surface to the deeper of the base of the Morrow formation or 9,772 feet subsurface to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools spaced on 320 acres within this vertical extent, which presently includes but are not necessarily limited to the Cemetary Morrow Gas Pool.
