WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:36 a.m.:

EXAMINER JONES: At this time let's call Case
13,515, which is the Application of Cheney Energy Partners
LLC for approval of a unit agreement, Chaves County, New
Mexico.

Call for appearances.

MS. MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Hearing Examiner. My name is Ocean Munds-Dry with Holland and Hart. I'm here on behalf of Cheney Energy Partners this morning.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, Cheney Energy Partners seeks approval of the Mescalero Springs State Exploratory Unit this morning. This unit is comprised of 1280 acres of State of New Mexico lands. It's located approximately four miles southwest of Caprock.

Cheney seeks approval of this proposed unit by affidavit, pursuant to Division Policy.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, if you'll turn to Cheney
Exhibit Number 1 you'll see the affidavit of Mitchel Cheney
who's the petroleum geologist and president of Cheney
Energy Partners. He identifies the project in his
affidavit.

If you turn to Attachment A to the affidavit, you'll see it's a copy of the unit agreement, and it conforms to the State Land Office form.

If you turn to Attachment B to the affidavit, you'll see it's a copy of the plat which identifies the unit boundary in red, and you'll see there's an arrow indicating where the proposed Mescalero Springs Unit is located.

Attachment C to the affidavit is a schedule of ownership. You'll note that Cheney has approximately 78 percent of the working interest committed to the unit. You'll also note at the bottom, there's some open acreage which was nominated at the June 21st sale. Cheney Energy Partners was not successful in obtaining that tract of land; however, they have made an offer to the -- I believe it was Yates Petroleum Corporation, to participate in the unit. And since that happened rather late, obviously, in this process, they're in those negotiations right now.

They do have 78 percent, as I noted, committed to the unit.

Cheney proposes to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation. The initial test well is to be located at a standard location 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, and they plan to test all formations from the surface to an approximate total depth of 12,000 feet.

If you turn to Attachment D to the affidavit, it's a letter from the Commissioner of Public Lands giving

preliminary approval to the formation of this unit.

And Attachment E is a montage of a middle Morrow stratigraphic cross-section, cross interval [sic] and sand isopachs and a top-of-Chester structure map. This shows the outlines of the incised valleys which they are attempting to explore. And you can note on each of the maps that they've shown you here on the montage that they do indicate where the exploratory unit is, with the red arrows on each of the maps.

With the proposed location, Cheney hopes to intersect the sands in the valley access, and they hope to have indicated that to you in each of these maps.

Cheney Exhibit Number 2 is an affidavit of publication showing you that proper notice was given to this proceeding.

And finally, Cheney Exhibit Number 3 is -- are copies of the notice letters that were sent to all the working interest owners. Yes, that's correct.

Finally, Mr. Cheney testifies that the development of this unit area is pursuant to a unit plan, is in the best interests of conservation, will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, if you have no questions we'd ask that Cheney Exhibits Number 1 through 3 and their attachments be admitted into evidence.
