That would be the Application of Yates 4 Petroleum Corporation for approval of a unit agreement, 5 Chaves County, New Mexico. 6 We will call for appearances in this case. 7 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 8 Examiner, my name is Ocean Munds-Dry with the law firm of 9 Holland and Hart, representing Yates Petroleum Corporation 10 11 this morning. 12 EXAMINER CATANACH: And let the record show there are no additional appearances in this case. 13 You may proceed. 14 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Hearing, Examiner, Yates 15 seeks approval of the Stadium State Exploratory Unit; it's 16 comprised of 960 acres of State of New Mexico lands and 17 located approximately six miles north of Dexter. Yates 18 19 seeks approval of this proposed unit by affidavit pursuant 20 to Division policy. 21 If you turn to Yates Exhibit Number 1, Mr.

Hearing Examiner, you'll see it's the affidavit of Mr. Tim

Miller who is the petroleum geologist identifying the

project.

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Attachment A to the affidavit is a copy of the

unit agreement, which you will note conforms to the State Land Office form.

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Attachment B to the affidavit is a copy of the plat to the unit agreement, identifying the unit boundary. Yates proposes to test all formations from the surface to the top of the Precambrian formation. The initial test well is to be located at a standard location 1980 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line of Section 16, Township 12 South, Range 26 East, to test all formations from the surface to an approximate total depth of 6175 feet.

Attachment C to the affidavit is a copy of the ownership breakdown. 100 percent of the working interest is owned by Yates and its affiliated companies. You will note that the first expiring lease is October 1st of 2005.

Attachment D to the affidavit is a letter from the Commissioner of the Public Lands giving preliminary approval to the formation of this unit.

Attachment E to the affidavit is a top of SiluroDevonian map. It shows that the proposed well location is
60 feet higher than the Supron, well which is in Section
16, in the southeast quarter.

Attachment F is a gross isopach Siluro-Devonian map and shows that the proposed well location would have about 275 feet of dolomite present.

Both Attachment G and H are net porosity maps.

One is for the Wolfcamp B zone and the other is for the Wolfcamp Spear zone. Both maps show prospective intervals that could be productive. The proposed location should encounter about 10 to 12 feet of net porosity greater than 4 percent.

Attachment I is a top-of-Wolfcamp structure map and also shows the Supron well is downdip from the Yates proposed location.

Finally, Attachment J to the affidavit is a cross-section. It shows both the Aztec well, the Hrubetz well, the Atlantic Richfield and Cities Services well, all tested for oil and gas in the Siluro-Devonian.

The Supron well did not test in the Siluro-Devonian but shows 12-percent porosity between 5900 and 5910 feet on the neutron density log. And Mr. Miller discusses that in more depth in his affidavit.

And then finally, Yates Exhibit Number 2 is an affidavit of publication showing that proper notice was given in this case. Mr. Miller testifies in his affidavit that the development of this unit area is pursuant to unit plan and is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.
