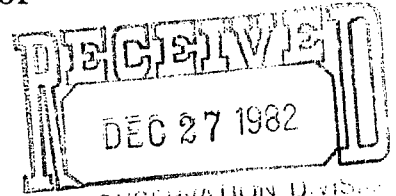

Gentlemen:

Your application of November 22, 1982 requesting approval of the twenty-fifth, twenty-sixth and twenty-seventh revisions of the Pictured Cliffs participating area, Lindrith Unit Agreement, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, was approved on this date effective November 1, 1979, January 1, 1981, and July 1, 1981.

The twenty-fifth, twenty-sixth and twenty-seventh revision adds 2080 acres to the participating areas described as: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 8, T. 24 N., R. 2 W., SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 3 and 36, T. 24 N., R. 3 W., SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 6, T. 24 N., R. 2 W., W $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 17, T. 24 N., R. 2 W., N $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 33, T. 24 N., R. 2 W., SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 3, T. 24 N., R. 3 W., NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 11, T. 24 N., R. 3 W., SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 21, T. 24 N., R. 3 W., SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 21, T. 24 N., R. 2 W., and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 21, T. 24 N., R. 3 W., in N.M.P.M., with these revisions the Pictured Cliffs participating area is enlarged to 14,976 acres.

The revisions are based upon the information obtained by the completion of unit wells Nos. 96, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 107, Jelly Dog Jerry #1, Jelly Dog Jerry #2, Joann's Jewel #2, and Di's Delight #1. Copies of the approved application are being distributed to the appropriate Federal offices and three approved copies are enclosed. You are requested to furnish the State of New Mexico and all other interested parties with appropriate evidence of this approval.
