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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 10:50 a.m.: 3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the Commission is Case Number 13,402, consolidated Application 4 5 of Loco Hills GSF for an exemption to the liner and leak detection requirements of 19.15.2.50.C NMAC and approval of 6 stage 1 and 2 abatement plans, with provisional alternate 7 abatement standards, Eddy County, New Mexico. 8 I understand that this case is to be continued, 9 and Mr. Carr, you represent Loco Hills in this? 10 MR. CARR: Yes, I do. 11 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: And is my understanding 12 correct on the continuance? 13 MR. CARR: We request a continuance. 14 15 MR. BROOKS: As I had indicated to the 16 Commission, there is no objection on the part of the 17 Division to that. 18 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Commissioner Bailey, 19 would there be a -- Is there a need to draft an order --20 MR. BROOKS: No --21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: -- for the continuance? MR. BROOKS: -- I believe not. I believe under 22 23 Rule -- I believe it's 1209, it can be continued by 24 announcement at the meeting and should be continued to the 25 May docket.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Case Number 13,402 will 1 be continued until the May 12th, 2005, Commission meeting. 2 3 4 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next case before the 5 6 Commission is Case Number 13,359, the de novo Application 7 of Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. 8 Is there an appearance in that case? 9 There is no one here representing 10 MR. BROOKS: any of the parties in that case, Mr. Chairman. Mr. Bruce 11 was here earlier, and he presented me with a stipulated 12 order of dismissal in that case, which is signed by all of 13 the attorneys of record on the case. It is not on the 14 15 legal-sized, hole-punched paper that Commission orders are normally entered upon, but it has been signed by all 16 17 parties. You might wish to ask Ms. Davidson how that can 18 19 be handled to preserve it in the manner in which we 20 normally preserve Commission orders, but it seems 21 appropriate to dismiss it pursuant to agreement. 22

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MS. DAVIDSON: We can just file it in the book along with the other orders. Better if it's on the regular paper, but it's okay this way.

> MR. BROOKS: Okay.

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Commissioner Bailey, 1 would you like to review that? 2 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I move we accept it. 3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Counsel Brooks, this directs 4 5 us to vacate a previous order. Is there any concern to the Commission for that vacation? 6 MR. BROOKS: I don't see that there would be, 7 8 since it's signed by all counsel of record in the case. 9 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. MR. BROOKS: It would be if it were not an agreed 10 order, but it is an agreed order. 11 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Commissioner Bailey, 12 did you move that we adopt this stipulated order of 13 dismissal? 14 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I do. 15 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: I second. All those in favor? 16 17 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Opposed? Let the record 18 reflect that stipulated order of dismissal in Case Number 19 20 13,359 will be signed by the Commission. 21 Also let the record reflect that there's a place on here for Commissioner Chavez to sign -- Commissioner 22 23 Chavez is absent today -- but that Commissioner Bailey and I have both signed, and that it is -- two members of the 24 25 Commission are a sufficient quorum to invoke the stipulated
