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as its agent, with full authority to act in its behalf in complying with the terms of the Unit Agreement and regulations applicable thereto, and on whom the supervisor or his representative may serve written or oral instructions in securing compliance with the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations with respect to drilling, testing and completing Unit Well No. 37, in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 8, T-25S, R-30E, N.M.P.M. Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is understood that this Designation of Agent does not relieve the Unit Operator of responsibility for compliance with the terms of the Unit Agreement and the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations. It is also understood that this Designation of Agent does not constitute an assignment of any interest under the Unit Agreement or any lease committed thereto.

In case of default on the part of the designated agent, the Unit Operator will make full and prompt compliance with all regulations, lease terms, or orders of the Secretary of the Interior or his representative.

The Unit Operator agrees promptly to notify the Oil and Gas Supervisor of any change in the designated agent.

This Designation of Agent is deemed to be temporary and in no manner a permanent arrangement.

This Designation is given only to enable the agent herein designated to drill the above specified Unit Well. Unless sooner terminated, this Designation shall terminate when there is filed in the appropriate district office of the U. S. Geological Survey a completed file of all required Federal reports pertaining to subject well. It is also understood that this Designation of Agent is limited to field operations and does not cover administrative action requiring specific authorization of the Unit Operator.

In compliance with Section 10 of the Poker Unit Agreement, dated July 16, 1952, Perry R. Bass, as Unit Operator, hereby submits for your approval a Plan of Development for 1968.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

Past development has consisted of drilling 32 shallow wells to various depths in search of Delaware or Lower Delaware production. Four wells are extremely deep wells, all of which were drilled below 13,500 feet.

Poker Lake Unit Well No. 36, operated by Pan American Petroleum Corporation, was drilled to total depth of 16,600 to the Devonian in January, 1967. The Devonian horizon potentialled for a calculated absolute open flow of 42.7 MMCFD on February 24, 1967, and after being placed on production at low flow rates produced only one and one-half days before loading up with water. The Devonian was abandoned on May 26, 1967 and the well recompleted to the Morrow gas zone. The Morrow potentialled with a CAOF of 2.4 MMCPD on June 14, 1967. During September, 1967, it produced an average of 921 MCFD.

Poker Lake Unit Well No. 37, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 8, T-25-S, R-30-E, was spudded on December 11, 1967 by Fred Pool. It is presently drilling at 663' with a projected total depth to adequately test the Delaware Sand.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

We are also evaluating performance of Unit Well No. 36 for the dual purpose of maintaining maximum producing capacity and determining the feasibility of additional development. We have no plans for additional development drilling; however, a supplemental plan will be filed if such is indicated to be appropriate.

ADDITIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This Plan of Development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement ending December 31, 1968. Before this plan expires, a subsequent Plan of Development will be forwarded for your approval.

MODIFICATION

It is understood that this Plan of Development may be modified from time to time to meet changing conditions.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Plan of Development shall be effective as of January 1, 1968. If this Plan meets with your approval, please indicate in the appropriate space and return one copy for our files.
