Schooler, and other mineral interest owners in the land described below: Cimarex Energy Co. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Case No. 13, 496 reopened) seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Permian-Upper Pennsylvanian formation underlying the SE/4NW/4 of Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and production unit. The unit is to be dedicated to the Caudill South "21" Fee Well No. 1 to be located 1830 feet from the north and west lines of Section 21. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, August 11, 2005 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The unit is located approximately 5 miles north-northeast of Lovington, New Mexico.
