#### **APPLICATION**

YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION ("Yates"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving a 307.72-acre non-standard gas spacing unit in the Mississippian formation, and in support thereof states:

1. Yates is the operator and a working interest owner of the W/2 of irregular Section 30, Township 12 South, Range 35 East on which it proposes to drill its Ike State Unit Well No. 1 at a standard location 1750 feet from the North line and 900 feet from the West line of the section.

2. This non-standard gas spacing unit is necessary because it contains only 307.72 acres due to a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Surveys.

3. This non-standard spacing unit is comprised of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots and lies wholly within a single governmental half section.

4. All tracts offsetting the proposed non-standard unit are operated by Yates Petroleum Corporation except for a tract operated by EOG Resources, Inc.

5. A copy of this application mailed to EOG Resources, Inc. by Certified Mail--Return Receipt Requested as required by Division Rule 1207.A(2).

6. Approval of this application will enable Yates to recover its just and equitable share of the reserves under this non-standard unit and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
