1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2 8:15 a.m.:

3 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: I will call this hearing to
4 order. Good morning, everybody. My name is Richard
5 Ezeanyim, as most of you know. And sitting by my left is
6 Gail MacQuesten, the Assistant General Counsel and also the
7 Division Counsel. She'll be helping me today.

8 Today is July 14th at approximately 8:15 a.m. in
9 the morning. We are going to consider Docket Number 22-05.
10 And as normal, we first of all call all the dismissals and
11 continuances this morning.

12 Page 1, Case Number 13,502 is dismissed; Case
13 Number 13,512 is dismissed; Case Number 13,519 is continued
14 to August 25.

15 Page 2, Case Number 13,521 is dismissed; Case
16 Number 13,510 is continued to August 25.

17 Page 3, Case Number 13,516 is dismissed; Case
18 Number 13,523 is continued to October 6th.

19 Page 4, Case Number 13,524 is continued to August
20 11; Case 13,153 is dismissed. This is good.

21 (Laughter)

22 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: We finally have that case
23 dismissed.

24 Well, then, the way we're going to conduct the
25 hearing today, there are easier ones and there are

1 contested cases. So what I think we're going to do is
2 first of all call Case Number 13,408, in that order,
3 13,408, 13,520, 13,522.

4 When we finish those, then we can then go to
5 contested cases, and those cases today are 13,506 -- this
6 came up yesterday evening -- and then 13,484. So we're
7 going to hear those last.

8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, in Case 13,408, Jim
9 Bruce, representing the Applicant. Is that the one we're
10 going first, or --

11 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: No, I'm trying to call it
12 now.

13 MR. BRUCE: Oh, 13,522, I think?

14 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: I want to do 13,408 first and
15 get -- Are you interested in that case, 13,408?

16 MR. BRUCE: Oh, that one, yes, that is --

17 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah, okay, that is the first
18 case I'm calling now.

19 MR. BRUCE: Right client, wrong file.

21 8:17 a.m.)


