Case No. 14919: Application of COG Operating LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling; Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order: (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Glorieta-Yesso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Bradley 8 Fee 4H well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 160 feet from the South line and 1040 feet from the East line (Unit P) to a bottom hole location 330 feet from the North line and 1040 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 8. The completed interval for this well will be within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 4 miles north-west of Lakewood, New Mexico.
