The BLM will object to the above request to Amend Order No. R-13443 to eliminating the requirements that Frontier place H2S warning flags or safety indicators on and potentially plug the identified and any later-completed offset wells. Please note that the wells mentioned in the reference order are Federal wellbores and will require federal approval for revision. The Maljamar AGI #1 was approved based upon the fact that the reference order will be enforced.

How does placing a H2S warning flag impair correlative rights and result in waste?
