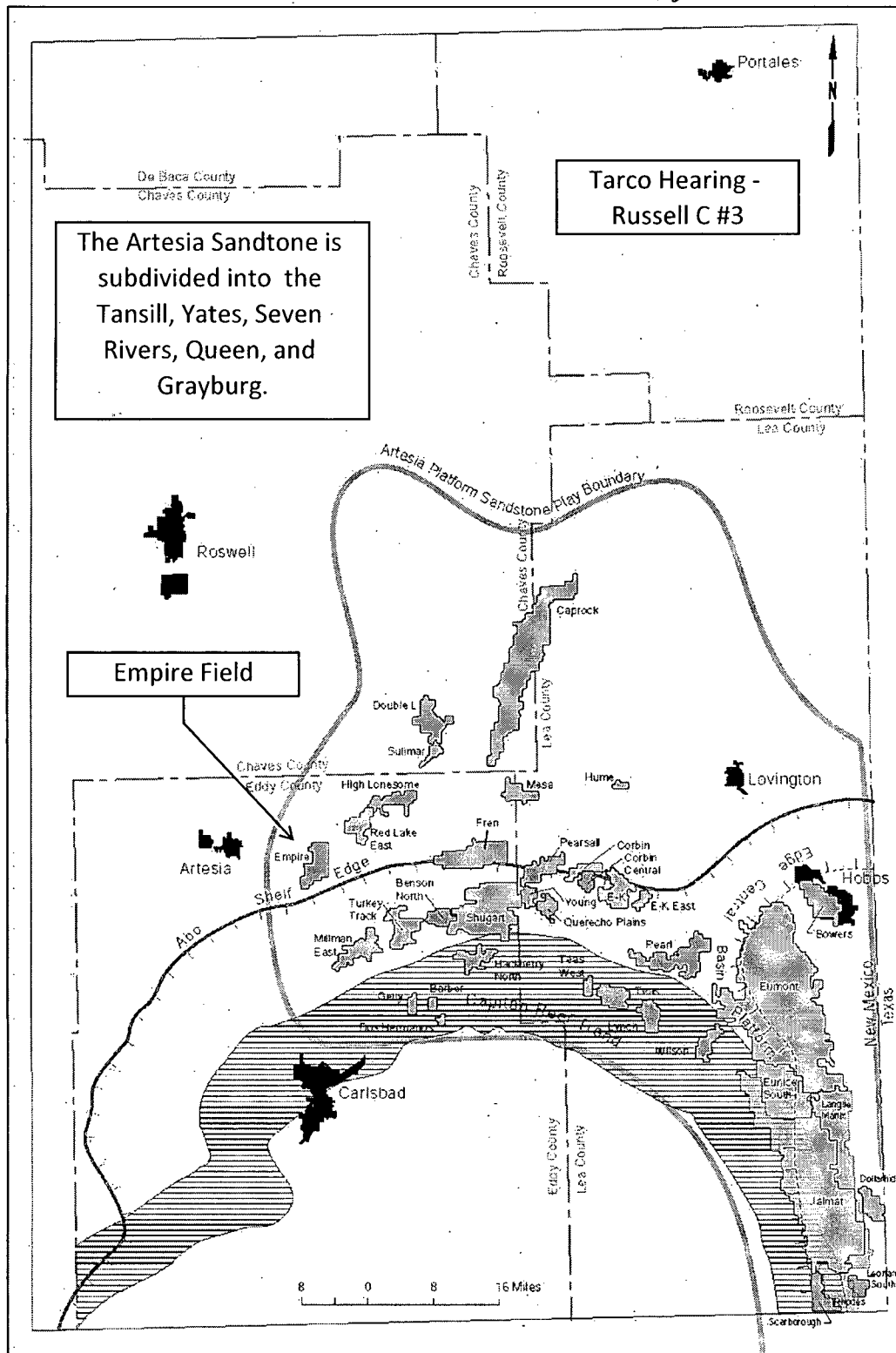

Location of reservoirs with more than 1 MMBO cumulative production in the New Mexico part of the Artesia Platform Sandstone play. Broadhead, et al, 2004

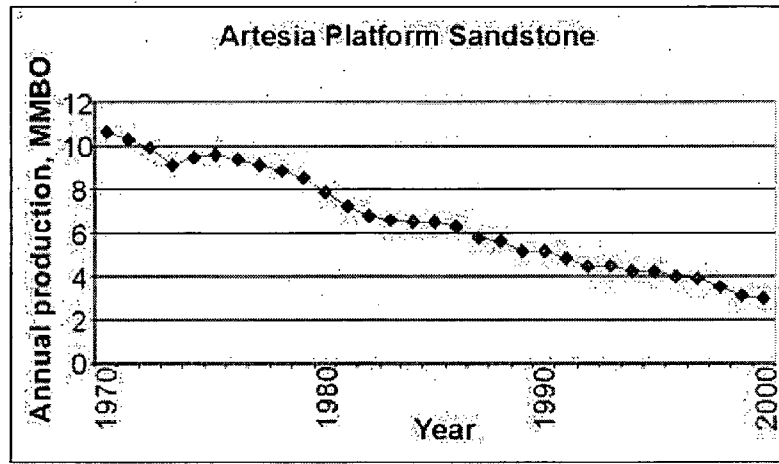


Figure 132-2. Historical annual production in southeast New Mexico from 1970 to 2000 from reservoirs with more than 1 MMBO cumulative production in the Artesia Platform sandstone play.
