

State Com. Well No. 4, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface location 150 feet from the north line and 2390 feet from the east line, with a terminus in the SW/4 SE/4, of Section 13. Applicant further requests unorthodox location approval of the above well in the Bone Spring formation. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The units are located approximately 6-1/2 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

7. **CASE 14961:** *(Continued from the March 7, 2013 Examiner Hearing.)*

Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit, an unorthodox oil well location, and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Delaware formation comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) in the Delaware formation underlying the E/2 E/2 of Section 13 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area), and (ii) from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 13, for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Lone Tree Draw 13 State Com. Well No. 5, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface location 150 feet from the north line and 990 feet from the east line, with a terminus in the SE/4 SE/4, of Section 13. Applicant further requests unorthodox location approval in the vertical portion of the above well from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The units are located approximately 6-1/2 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

8. **CASE 14968:** *Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.*

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an order approving a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Delaware formation comprised of the W/2SW/4 of Section 30 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Delaware formation underlying the non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area). The unit is to be dedicated to the Harroun Trust 31-30 Fed. Com. Well No. 2H, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 31, with a terminus in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 30. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 1 mile northwest of Harroun, New Mexico.

9. **CASE 14969:** *Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.*

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an order approving a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Delaware formation comprised of the E/2SW/4 of Section 30 and the E/2W/2 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Delaware formation underlying the non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area). The unit is to be dedicated to the Harroun Trust 31 Well No. 3H, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface location in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 31, with a terminus in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 30. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 1 mile northwest of Harroun, New Mexico.

10. **CASE 14936:** *(Re-opened):*

Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. to Re-open Case No. 14936 to amend the special rules and regulations for the Northwest Fenton-Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order amending the temporary special rules and regulations for Northwest Fenton-Delaware Pool to provide for a special depth bracket allowable of 300 barrels of oil per day for a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit, effective as of November 1, 2012. The pool includes all or parts of Sections 1, 2, and 11-14 of Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, and Sections 7 and 8 of Township 21 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The Northwest Fenton-Delaware Pool is centered approximately 7-1/2 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
