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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying this acreage. This non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's existing Falabella 31 Fee 6H Well, which has been horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) to a standard bottom hole location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit C) of Section 31. The completed interval for this well is within the 330-foot standard offset required by Division rules.


