RE: CASE NUMBER 14664 - FRONTIER FIELD SERVICES, LLC MALJAMAR AGI #1

This letter is to notify you that Frontier Field Services, LLC ("Frontier") filed the enclosed Motion to Amend Order No. R-13443 on January 11, 2013, with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission ("Commission"). Order No. R-13443 authorizes Frontier to inject treated acid gas into its Maljamar AGI #1 well, which is next to the Frontier Gas Processing Plant near Maljamar, New Mexico. The well is located 130 feet from the South line and 1813 feet from the East line of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East. Frontier's motion requests the Commission to amend Order No. R-13443 by eliminating certain conditions that pertain to offset wells and lowering the uppermost elevation of the permitted disposal interval.

The motion has been set for hearing before the Commission at 9:00 a.m. on February 14, 2013, in Porter Hall at the Commission's Santa Fe office located at 1220 South St. Francisco Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as the operator of an offset well(s) identified in Order No. R-13443 that may be affected by Frontier's motion, you may appear at the hearing and present testimony. If you do not appear at the hearing and become a party of record you will be precluded from challenging the motion at a later date.

A party appearing at the hearing is required by the Commission's rules to file a Pre-Hearing Statement with the Commission's Santa Fe office no later than one week prior to the hearing date. This statement must be served on counsel for Frontier and on all other parties and should include: your name and the name of your attorney, if any; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses you will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time you will need to present your case; and an identification of any procedural matters that need to be resolved prior to the hearing.
