2 EXAMINER BROOKS: This is the New Mexico
3 Oil Conservation Division Docket Number 8-13.

4 Before I start with the continuances and
5 dismissals, I wanted to introduce our new examiner.
6 Some of you have met him, but since we have a cast of
7 thousands this morning, this is kind of introducing
8 Phillip Goetze.

9 You want to wave, Mr. Goetze? I think they
10 all see you.

11 EXAMINER GOETZE: For those who can't, yes
12 I'm Phillip Goetze, the new examiner.

13 EXAMINER BROOKS: He's in the dark there
14 because the light is out for some reason. But I've been
15 in the dark here for 12 years (laughter).

16 Continuances and dismissals on page 1:
17 Case 14956 is continued to March the 21st.

18 Page 2: Case 14957 is continued to March
19 21st. Case 14946 is continued to March 21st. Case
20 Number 14961 is continued to March 21st.

21 On page 3: Case 14959 is continued to
22 April the 4th. Case 14963 is continued to March 21st.

23 And on the back page, we have an issue
24 here. Both parties want to continue. This is Case
25 Number 8352, re-opened. Both parties want to continue

1 it, but they don't agree on what date they can continue
2 it to. So what's --

3 MR. FELDEWERT: I'll quibble with you a
4 little bit, Mr. Brooks. I'm representing OXY USA. We
5 did not want to continue this. They requested a
6 continuance for four weeks. We said, That's fine; we'll
7 continue it for four weeks. And then when they filed
8 their request, it was for six weeks. So we called them
9 back and said, Wait a minute; you said four weeks. So
10 we would ask it only be four weeks.

11 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. In order to get
12 this matter resolved -- is there anyone appearing here
13 for the opposing party?

14 Okay. Well, since one side appeared and
15 the other side didn't, Case Number 8352 will be
16 continued to April 4th.

17 Okay. Are there any additions or
18 corrections to the continuances?

19 There aren't any dismissals.

20 If anybody would like to make a dismissal,
21 we would certainly entertain it.
