EOG seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 27, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Red Hills; Bone Spring Upper Shale Pool underlying this acreage. The completed interval for this well will be within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Division's rules. The pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will

protect correlative rights. EOG should be designated the operator of this proposed horizontal well and spacing unit.
