2 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: In the case of 14981,
3 which was the application of Occidental Permian Limited
4 Partnership to amend Orders R-4934 and R-4934-E
5 governing the South Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Pressure
6 Maintenance Project to allow the injection of carbon
7 dioxide and produced gases, to modify the surface
8 injection pressure, to obtain other relief, and to
9 qualify this expansion for the recovered oil tax rate
10 pursuant to the New Mexico Enhanced Oil Recovery Act,
11 Lea County, New Mexico.

12 Commissioners, have you had a chance to
13 look at the order as proposed to the Commission?

14 COMMISSIONER WARNELL: I have.

15 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: Yes?

16 MR. BRANCARD: Madam Chair, let me just
17 note that there has been one small change in the order
18 that we made yesterday. Florene caught something, and
19 with the help of Mr. Feldewert, we cleared it up.

20 There is a reference in the order paragraph
21 to two exhibits, Exhibits A and B, which lists all the
22 wells current and proposed. That's been changed to one
23 exhibit, an exhibit that was part of the testimony that
24 lists all the wells together, but you can clearly
25 indicate from the exhibit which ones are current and

1 which ones are proposed. So that's the change. What
2 used to be referred to as Exhibits A and B is now
3 Exhibit A.

4 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: Commissioners, would
5 you like to take a look at that?

6 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Pretty clear.

7 MR. BRANCARD: And that list was part of
8 the C-108 application.

9 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: It looks clear to me.
10 But no other changes were made to the body
11 of the order?

12 MR. BRANCARD: No.

13 CHAIRPERSON DIXON: So they accurately
14 reflect the Commission's deliberations in this case?

15 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: Do I hear a motion to
17 adopt the order?

18 COMMISSIONER BALCH: I'll make a motion to
19 adopt the order.

20 COMMISSIONER WARNELL: Second that motion.

21 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: All those in favor?

22 (Ayes are unanimous.)

23 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: We have all signed the
24 order, and it will be transmitted to the Commission
25 secretary.
