The captioned case was heard at the August 25, 2005 examiner hearing before Hon. Richard Ezeanyiam.

At that time, I was unaware that notice had been published, and since it appeared that the address to which notice was mailed to Mr. Pate was not actually his address, the case was continued to the September 22 hearing docket so that notice could be published.
