The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, August 25, 2005 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. The unit is located approximately 2 miles northeast of Bloomington, New Mexico.
