Cimarex Energy, Co ("Cimarex"), hereby proposes to drill the Chaparral 33 Fed Com #4 well at a legal location in the W/2E/2, Section 33-19S-34E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The intended surface hole location for the well is 330' FNL & 2010' FEL and the intended bottom hole location is 330 FSL & 1980' FEL. The well is proposed to be drilled vertically to a depth of approximately 10,953' to the Bone Spring formation and laterally in a westerly direction within the formation to the referenced bottom hole location. Total measured depth of the well is proposed to be approximately 15,700' from surface to terminus.


It should be understood that compliance with topography or cultural or environmental concerns, among others, might require modification of Cimarex's intended procedure. Cimarex will advise you of any such modifications.

Enclosed, in duplicate, is our detailed AFE reflecting estimated costs associated with this proposal and proposed Operating Agreement. Please indicate your participation in the well by approving and returning one (1) original of the enclosed AFE, along with duplicate signature pages for the Operating Agreement and Memorandum of Operating Agreement and contact information to receive your well data, to the undersigned within thirty (30) days of receipt of this proposal. If you elect to purchase your own well control insurance, you must provide a certificate of such insurance to Cimarex prior to commencement of drilling operations; otherwise, you will be covered by insurance procured by Cimarex and will be responsible for your share of the cost. A copy of the fully executed signature pages to the Operating Agreement and Memorandum will be forwarded to you once available.


