

COG Operating, LLC has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as follows: Case No. 15029: Application of COG Operating, LLC for Designation of a Non-standard Spacing Unit and for Compulsory Pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order consolidating the 40-acre spacing units within the E/2/E/2 of Section 11 and the NE/4/NE/4 of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM and designating the consolidated units as a 200-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit for a well location in the Yeso formation for Applicant's horizontal drilling project area. Applicant further seeks the compulsory pooling of all interests in the Yeso formation underlying the E/2/E/2 of Section 11 and the NE/4/NE/4 of Section 14 to be dedicated to its Flat Head Fed. Com. No. 8-H Well to be drilled horizontally from a surface location in the NE/4/NE/4 of Section 14 to a depth sufficient to test the Yeso formation. West Mallamar Yeso Pool (44500). Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator and a charge for risk involved in drilling the well.
