APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order (i) approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S¹/₂S¹/₂ of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the S¹/₂S¹/₂ of Section 21, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Young 21 PM Fed. Com. Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate the S¹/₂S¹/₂ of Section 21 to the well to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing. The well is a horizontal well, with a surface location in the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄, and a terminus in the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄, of Section 21.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the $S\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the S½S½ of Section 21, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17, 18.

5. Approval of the non-standard unit and the pooling of all mineral interests underlying the S½S½ of Section 21 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Approving a non-standard oil spacing and protation unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the $S^{1}_{2}S^{1}_{2}$ of Section 21;

B. Pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the $S\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21;

C. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

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D. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;

E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving an 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 21 for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Young 21 PM Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE/4SE/4, and a terminus in the SW/4SW/4, of Section 21. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 9 miles south of Maljamar, New Mexico.

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
