This is to advise that Sundown Energy LP has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval to conduct waterflood operations to support production from its Reeves Queen Unit Waterflood Project by converting the following wells to injection:

Arco 28 State Well No. 1

Applicant proposes injection of water at average daily rates of approximately 500 bbls and at maximum daily rates of approximately 1,000 bbls.

This Application will be set for hearing before a Division Examiner on October 3, 2013, at 8:15 a.m. at the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
