COG proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit as the project area for its Sebastian Federal Com 1H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the -NW/4NW/4 (Lot 1) to a standard bottom hole location in the SW/4SW/4 (Lot 4) of

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Section 18. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Division's rules.
