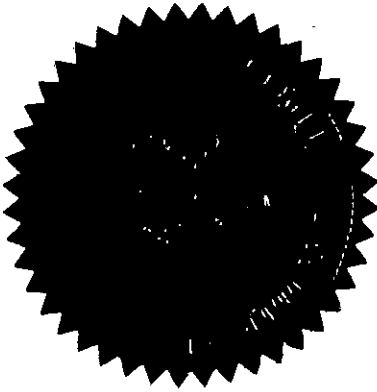
**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO VACATE ORDER AND DISMISS
