Gentlemen:

On January 23rd this company received from Mr. Brooks a notice that a hearing has been scheduled for February 22, 2002 in which the OCD will seek assessment of civil penalties for this company's failure to bring into compliance one well, the Louise Yates State # 1.

We request that you remove Jalapeno from the hearing docket for the reason that it is not out of compliance in regard to the subject well. The following is a recent history in regard to the well:

Last year on August 7th, after having retrieved information off the OCD web site related to Jalapeno's operated wells, I wrote Mr. Gum a letter, a copy of which is enclosed. In the letter I requested that the OCD information be corrected as to several wells including the Louise Yates State # 1. Mr. Gum's response was included in a letter of August 8th addressed to me c/o of Cibola Energy Corporation. A copy of Mr. Gum's letter is enclosed.

Mr. Gum's response stated that the Commission was not requesting that the well be plugged, only that it be brought into compliance. Because I did not understand why the well was considered to be out of compliance (we were working to determine whether it would make a disposal well), I called Mr. Gum. As you will see from my note made on Mr. Gum's letter, I understood him to say that we should file a Sundry Notice notifying the OCD that the well was

going to be converted to a disposal well and, thereafter, we should file the related application with the Santa Fe OCD office.


A few days later, on August 16th, pursuant to Mr. Gum's statement, the required Sundry Notice was filed with the Artesia OCD office. (A copy of Anne Riggs' cover letter together with a copy of the Sundry Notice are enclosed.) Because an approved copy of the August 16th Sundry Notice had not been returned to us by the Artesia OCD office, Anne Riggs sent, on January 24, 2002, a second notice to Artesia. (A copy of her second Sundry Notice and related cover letter are enclosed.) Today, February 7, 2002, we finally received from the OCD in Artesia a copy of the August 16, 2001 Sundry Notice which was stamped by the OCD: "December 31", "For Record Only." The mail receipt stamp on the Sundry Notice indicates that the OCD office had received the Notice on August 20, 2001 -- more than five months before it was returned to Jalapeno. (I enclose a copy of the returned Sundry Notice as well as a copy of the return envelope which was mailed to Jalapeno from Artesia on February 5th.)

While preparing the "Application" to convert the well to a disposal well, Anne Riggs, because she had not previously prepared such an application, at various times discussed with Mr. Catanach, of the Santa Fe OCD office, various questions related to the Application. I also discussed the pending application with Mr. Catanach.

The above history indicates clearly that even though the OCD is now attempting to hold Jalapeno liable for being non compliant regarding the Louise Yates State # 1, the OCD itself, prior to the issuance of Mr. Brooks' letter, was well aware that Jalapeno was in the process of preparing an application to convert the well to a disposal well and was itself quite tardy (noncompliant?) in acknowledging our submission of the Sundry Notice requested by Mr. Gum in August 2001 to bring the well into compliance.

On January 30th the advertisements required by the Application were commissioned at the Roswell newspaper. On February 1, 2002, copies of the completed Application to convert the Louise Yates State # 1 to a water disposal well were mailed to the Artesia OCD office, to Mr. Catanach at the Santa Fe OCD office, and to the BLM, State Land Office, and affected parties. (A copy of the return receipt from the Artesia OCD and the Santa Fe OCD office are enclosed.)

I request that you remove this company from your docket February 22nd and that you change your records to show that Jalapeno is fully compliant in regard to the Louise Yates State # 1.

Dear Mr. Gum:

We recently got information off of the OCD web site related to the wells operated by Jalapeno Corporation. (See, attached the web site information.) That information is not correct in regard to several wells. We would appreciate your updating the OCD information to correct it.

DUNCAN FEDERAL 4Y: This company, rather than Cibola Energy Corporation, operates the subject well. (See the attached change of operator form which was approved by the BLM on January 27, 2000.) We would appreciate your adding the 4Y to this company's list of wells and deleting it from your list of Cibola operated wells. You will notice from the web site information that the OCD shows the other Duncan Federal wells, which were included on the same change of operator form, as being operated by Jalapeno.

Several years ago, when Cibola did operate this well, it filed with the OCD in Santa Fe an application to convert this well to a water disposal well. That permission was granted, subject to Cibola's doing certain work on surrounding wells to make sure those bore holes were protected from disposed water. The required work was done, but the time limit set under the OCD Order allowing water disposal, had expired before the work was completed. After Jalapeno assumed operations of the well we again contemplated requesting renewed authority from the OCD to inject water into the Duncan 4Y. However, a further examination of the well logs, as well as the results of a pressure test which was conducted on the well, have led us to conclude that the injection pressures would be too great to justify using the Duncan 4Y as a disposal well. Consequently, we decided to plug this well. An application to plug the well was approved by the BLM on June 27, 2001 and Basic Services, a Texas plugging company, has agreed to plug it. (We enclose a copy of the approved plugging application.) We were advised by Basic that they would have a rig in the area either around August 15th or September 5th, and that the well would be plugged then.

A casing integrity test was conducted on the well on November 30, 2000. Both the OCD and the BLM were notified prior to the test that it would be conducted. Neither chose to send a


witness. We enclose a copy of the Sundry Notice filed with the BLM as well as a copy of the pressure chart.

ROX # 3 (15856): This well was plugged on April 24, 1995. (Please see attached the plugging report approved by Ken Livingston of the OCD on September 15, 1995.) We would appreciate your having the well removed from the OCD web site.

WHITNEY # 1 & WHITNEY # 5 (13909): Your records show that the Whitney # 1 has not been producing. Though the Whitney # 1 was down for an extended period, it was put back on production in 2000, and produced into a common tank battery with the Whitney # 5. (Enclosed is a copy of a letter from the oil purchaser, Phillips, evidencing that the well was producing.) Because of confusion arising from the fact that the Whitney 1 was producing into the same tank as the Whitney 5, the person doing the C-115s failed to indicate that the Whitney 1 was contributing part of the production. When this mistake was discovered, corrected C-115s were filed. In any case, both of these wells were sold to Paloma Blanca Well Service Co. effective June 30, 2001. A copy of the change of operator form, which was filed in Artesia with the OCD, is enclosed. We would appreciate your removing these wells from the Jalapeno portion of the OCD web site.

LOUISE YATES STATE # 1 (-28049). This well was drilled to 3,322 ft, and subsequently plugged back to 2,366 ft. (See, the attached Sundry Notice dated 3/27/98, as well as the initial completion report of 5/28/97.) It was completed as a producer in the Slaughter zone of the San Andres formation on 3/13/98. However, production was less than anticipated and the well was shut in soon thereafter. This well is located in the Wolfe Lake San Andres field which is producing a significant amount of water. Since we abandoned the idea of using the Duncan 4Y as a water disposal well (see above), we are examining the possibilities of using the Louise Yates State # 1 as the disposal well instead. Thus, we prefer not to plug the well at this time.
