

Case No. 1504: Application of COG Operating LLC for non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant (in above styled cause) seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 60-acre spacing proration unit comprised of the N/2, N/2 of Section 5, Township 26 South, Range East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in Bona Spring formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Gunter 5 Field comm. H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE 1/4 NE 4, (Unit A) to a standard bottom hole location in the NW 1/4 NW 4 (Unit B) of Section 5. The completed interval for this well will be within the 30-foot standard of size required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereas, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well and a 20% charge for risks involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 19 miles southwest of Jala, New Mexico.
