

3 the Commission in Case 15127, which was the matter of an
4 application of DCP Midstream, LP for authorization to
5 inject acid gas into the Artesia AGI #2 well in Eddy
6 County, New Mexico.

7 Mr. Brancard, did you say that this order
8 is consistent with other orders that we have issued for
9 acid gas injection wells?

10 MR. BRANCARD: Yes, Madam Chair. DCP
11 prepared a draft order, and I tried to make it
12 consistent with the conditions we've had in previous
13 orders, along with the conditions that the parties
14 agreed to at the hearing. And I believe we've achieved
15 that. And we also proofread it for all possible little
16 mistakes, so we can avoid happening what happened last
17 time.

18 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: No nunc pro tuncs.

19 MR. BRANCARD: That's right.

20 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: All right.

21 Commissioners, have you had a chance to look at the
22 final draft that was as of yesterday afternoon?

23 COMMISSIONER BALCH: I have.

24 COMMISSIONER WARNELL: I have.

25 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: Do I hear a motion for


