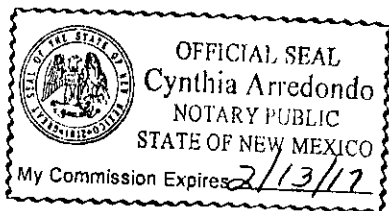

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the E/2 of Section 35, Township 23, South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Layla 35 W20B Fee Well No. 3H, a horizontal well with a surface location 185 feet from the south line and 2435 feet from the east line, and a terminus 330 feet from the north line and 2150 feet from the east line of Section 35.
