To: Don Angle, Gladys Angle, and Richard Jackson, Trustee of the John Holmstrom 2004 Trust, or their successors, heirs, devisees, or assigns: Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2N/2 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2N/2 of Section 23 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Antares 23 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NW/4NW/4, and a terminus in the NE/4NE/4, of Section 23. Also to be considered will be the designation of applicant as operator of the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, May 29, 2014 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 14 miles southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
