I. <u>CASE NOS. 14669, 14670, 14758, and 14759</u>: (Reopened)

Application of COG Operating LLC, to make permanent the Special Rules adopted under Order R-13523 for the Dodd Glorieta Upper Yeso Pool and the Burch Keely Glorieta Upper Yeso Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order making permanent the Special Rules adopted under Division Order R-13523 for the Dodd Glorieta Upper Yeso Pool (Pool Code 97917) and the Burch Keely Glorieta Upper Yeso Pool (Pool Code 97918). These pools cover all or parts of Sections 10-14 and 22-26 of Township 17 South, Range 29 East and Sections 18, 19 and 30 of Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, and are located approximately 12 miles East of Artesia and 17 mile West of Lovington, New Mexico.

2. <u>CASE 15205</u>: (This case will be continued to the <u>October 16</u>; 2014 Examiner Hearing.)

Application of COG Operating, LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation (Corbin; Bone Spring South Pool) underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Scooter Federal Com 1H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location 190 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line (Unit D) to a bottom hole location 330 feet from the South line and 380 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 23. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of the costs thereof, the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 8 miles Southwest of Buckeye, New Mexico.
