Applicant seeks an order revoking the injection authority granted under Administrative Orders SWD-1269 and SWD-649-B to Mesquite SWD, Inc. to dispose of produced water into the following wells operated by Mesquite: (i) the Heavy Metal 12 Federal Well No. 1 (API 30-015-29602), which is located 1,900 feet from the South line and 1,900 feet from the West line, Unit Letter K of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 31 East in Eddy County; and (ii) the Bran SWD Well No. 1 (API 30-015-25697), which is located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line, Unit Letter P of Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 31 East in Eddy County.

 Applicant intends to present evidence that Mesquite's produced water injection operations are adversely impacting BOPCO producing wells in the Poker Lake Unit, thereby impairing Applicant's correlative rights and causing waste. Applicant's Poker Lake Unit producing wells are located approximately 26 miles southeast of
